## I, LINDA YOUNG, declare:

- 1. I have worked for nearly 18 years in the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) and its predecessors-in-interest. I make this declaration from my own personal knowledge. If called as a witness, I could and would competently testify to the contents of this declaration.
- 2. I am currently working for ATF as an Area Supervisor for the Seattle Field Division and assigned to the Spokane office, the Field Division encompasses the states of Alaska, Hawaii, Idaho, Oregon and Washington as well as the Pacific Trust Territories and Guam. An Area Supervisor supervises investigators who conduct inspections to assess firearms and explosives industry compliance with the Gun Control Act and the Violent Crime Control Act of 1970.
- 3. On May 23, 2007, ATF commenced an inspection of Red's Trading Post (Red's) at its
